*We also enclose sketch showing alternative construction of the lower part of the longitudinal bulkhead.

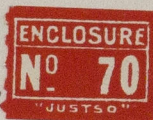
We will be pleased to have your approval of these plans as soon as possible, also preliminary assignment of freeboard, and enclose the necessary particulars form for this purpose.

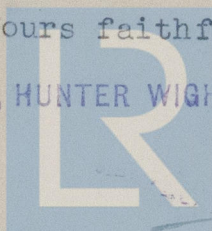
