We are in receipt of your letter (H) of the 14th ultimo with reference to the motor-ship "MONTROLITE". This vessel was under survey by Mr. Marlborough on January 13th last, and the vessel sailed before the recommendations made by him were seen, the owners Superintendent stating that he had forgotten to call him. It was understood that a Canadian Government Surveyor had seen the repairs. Mr. Marlborough stated that the survey had been overlooked through not being advised of the completion of the repairs recommended and his Rpt. 9 on the case was not forwarded until April 20th last, Rpt. No. 3985.
