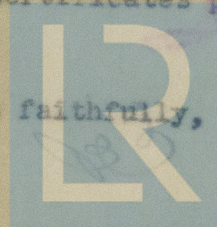
With further reference to your letter of the 26th inst., we would prefer, in the circumstances, that you do not send any documents on the matters under review to the Builders.

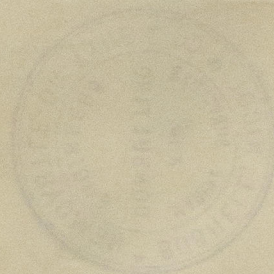
