

We understand that Lloyd's Register are authorised by the Canadian Government Steamship Inspection Department to provide the necessary certificates for one Season's trading in Canadian Waters. We rely on you supplying the Master with the necessary Certificates and a copy to ourselves.

We have in the past had no difficulty in getting these on request from your Society.

The Canadian Authorities are most particular that the correct Certificates should be on board.

With reference to the last paragraph of your letter, so far as we understand from discussions and the letter we have received from London, your views on this matter are not in accord with what we believe to be correct or with what will be satisfactory to the Owners. It would appear to us that such views as you have expressed in the present con-
