

Copy of letter dated 26th March 1938 addressed by the
Sunderland Surveyors to Messrs. Bushell, Nicol & Co.
(communicated by telephone, 29.3.38)

Dear Sirs,

We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25th instant respecting the Steamer "CORABELLA". With reference to your request for a Canadian Certificate for this vessel, our information on the subject indicates that vessels holding a certificate from Lloyd's Register are exempted from Canadian Government Inspection during the currency of the certificate, and we believe that certificates of classification based on the present survey of your vessel are all that will be required.

Accordingly we propose to forward our reports on the present survey to London sufficiently early to enable the Committee to issue certificates before the vessel's departure, and we shall be glad to know that this arrangement meets your wishes.

Messrs. J.L. Thompson & Sons have expressed a desire to be furnished with a statement of our findings in connection with the stern frame of the "CORABELLA", and we shall be glad to have your authority to comply with their request.
