the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners' Representatives, Messrs. Bushell Nicol & Co., Newcastle-on-Tyne, survey the s.s. "CORABELLA", 5682 tons gross, of London, on the 15th March 1939 and subsequently, whilst the vessel lay in dry dock at Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson's Yard, Wallsend-on-Tyne, for the purpose of examining the condition of the Superheater Element Tubes of the three Main Boilers.

The Superheater Tubes were examined in place in the boilers and afterwards at the Works of The North Eastern Marine Eng. Co. (1938) Ltd., Wallsend-on-Tyne.

The Undersigned, upon examination:-

FOUND.

All the tube ends in the combustion chambers of all three Boilers generally overheated & distorted. Several specimen ends were cut up for internal inspection and no undue deposit or scale was found.

RECOMMENDED.

All tube ends to be cut off and renewed, tested to Rule requirements and all the tubes to be refitted in the Boilers.

The Repairs recommended have now been satisfactorily carried out.
