S. I duly received your letter of the 27th instant reporting the circumstances attendant upon your inspection of the Steamer "DOVER HILL", and in reply have to say that provided all necessary repairs are carried out to your satisfaction and the vessel is placed in an efficient condition, the Committee will not object to the Owners' proposal to complete the Second Special Survey No.2 on her return to this country within three months.

I may add that an investigation is being made into the strength of the deck which collapsed.

As regards her Freeboard Certificate, this is of course valid until the 31st of December, 1939, but I have to say that in view of the vessel's condition as reported, it is considered desirable that an Annual Survey should be held at this time, and the Report C 11 is enclosed for your guidance.
