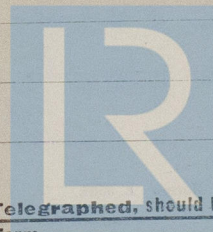

## NOTICE TO THE SENDER OF THIS TELEGRAM.

*This Telegram will be accepted for Transmission subject to the Telegraph Acts and Regulations made thereunder and in particular to the following Conditions :-*

1. The charge for transmission will cover the cost of delivery during ordinary office hours from the usual Delivery Office if the address is within three miles from that office or within the limits of the Town Postal delivery of that Office (when it is a Head Post Office) if that delivery extends to more than three miles.
2. The charge for delivery during ordinary office hours at any address beyond the limits of free delivery will be at the rate of 6d. for each mile or fraction of a mile, reckoned from the limits of free delivery. This charge will be payable by the Sender, and if it is not prepaid, the Telegram may, at the discretion of the Postmaster-General, be delivered by Post.
3. A reply not exceeding 48 words in length may be prepaid, in which case a Form will be delivered with the Telegram entitling the holder within twelve months to frank an Inland Telegram not exceeding in length the number of words indicated on the Form. If the Form is not used, its value will be returned from Headquarters to the Sender of the original Telegram within twelve months of its issue if application, accompanied by the Form, is made through the local Postmaster.
4. A Telegram can be repeated back from Office to Office throughout the course of transmission if the Sender desires to adopt this precaution against error. The charge for repetition (which must be paid when the Telegram is handed in) is one-half the charge for transmission. (Any telegram containing mercantile quotations or code words ought always to be repeated.)
5. The word "Private" may be inserted at the beginning of the address of a fully addressed Telegram at the cost of the Sender. The Telegram will then be delivered by messenger even though the addressee's Telegrams are ordinarily delivered by telephone. This arrangement does not apply, however, to any telegram bearing a telephonic address, or, except under the registrant's instructions, to any telegram bearing a registered abbreviated address.
6. The Postmaster-General will not be liable for any loss or damage which may be incurred or sustained by reason or on account of any mistake or default in the transmission or delivery of a Telegram.
7. Any application respecting this Telegram must be made within three months from the date of its transmission.
