From a statement made by the Master -

"During berthing operations at Trincomalee on February 19th. 1943, the vessel overran and damaged an oil jetty, but no damage to the vessel was suspected."

On examination of the vessel's stem, no damage of any sort could be found. On making further enquiries as to how the accident happened I satisfied myself that no damage could have been sustained to the vessel.
