M/S "MAYGLEN"

I revert to your letter of the 11th May, with which you enclosed a letter from Snr. Parreira Cruz, requesting duplicate copies of various documents relating to the above ship.

The Lisbon Surveyors were requested to arrange to examine the salvaged anchors, cables and shackles and report the markings, together with the markings on any machinery items salvaged and for which a certificate is likely to have been issued. They now report that most of the transportable articles from this wreck are in the extreme South of Portugal. As the necessary inspection of this material would involve a considerable time away from Lisbon, they have advised Snr. Parreira Cruz of the circumstances and are now awaiting his written consent to the Survey, including responsibility for payment of the charges.

I will write to you again when Snr. Parreira Cruz has made his decision.
