The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

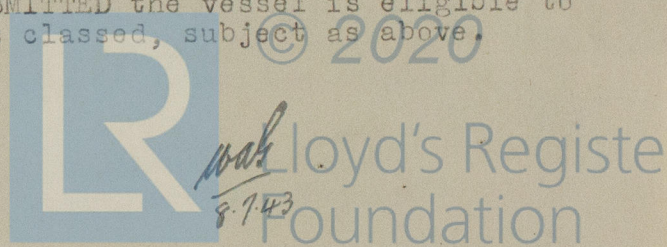

The class is subject to indented shell plating etc. (s.s.) in way of No2.hold and indented shell plates F.7, G.8 & 9 (s.s.a.) and frames in way and C.6 (p.s.f.) being dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

The MANCHESTER Surveyors report the vessel afloat and repairs effected to a fractured shell and fractured bulkhead plate. Additional accommodation fitted in Nos.4,5 & 6 Upper 'tween Decks.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed, subject as above.
