We are in receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo respecting the motorship "KONGSGAARD" and in reply have to state that the compressors attached to the dynamo oil engines and their air coolers and pumping arrangements have been examined and found satisfactory.

The main scavenge pumps, the steam driven compressor and its engine have not been examined. It was pointed out to the Chief Engineer that these items remained to be examined, but as the work was carried out by a reduced engine room staff it could not be completed in time.

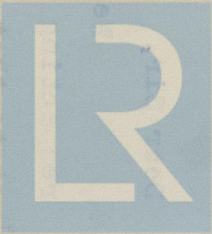
