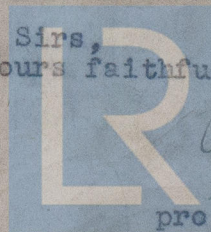
The case has been submitted for the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, who regret to note that owing to the present difficult economical conditions of shipping you have decided to discontinue the classification of this vessel in the Society's Register Book, and in the circumstances instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
