The Boiler Survey became due on this vessel 7,31 and the Screwshaft Survey 6,31.

In October last the Classing Committee agreed to the Screwshaft Survey being deferred until next May, or June at the latest, but required that the Boiler Survey should be carried out at the next cleaning, which it was anticipated would be in November.

In February last the Classing Committee agreed to a further postponement of the Boiler Survey until March, or, at latest, the present month, in view of an examination made of the Boiler in June last by the Inspector to the National Boiler & General Insurance Co. Ltd., a copy of whose report was forwarded.

In reply the Owners now write as follows :-

"We have carefully considered whether we are justified in keeping the above Tug classed and now respectfully beg to inform you we have decided to no longer avail ourselves of your Society's highly appreciated and valuable assistance in connection with the periodical surveys of the hull, boiler and machinery of the "KEVERNE"."

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 22nd instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
