The class of this vessel was withdrawn from the Register Book in 1923 at the Owners' request.

The S.S. No. 3 for re-classification has been partly held.

The Malta Surveyor, who was authorised to complete the survey, now reports the S.S. No. 3 has been completed and minor repairs effected.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to have her class reinstated with record of survey 5.30 and notation of S.S. No. 3-5.30.


