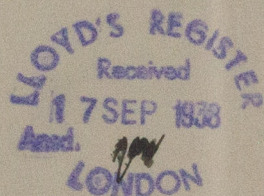

We have to add that the boiler has been examined internally and externally and found in good order.

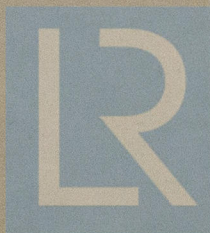
