

Dear Sir,

We have to acquaint you that Messrs. Morgan & Birchall, Consulting Engineers, have surveyed on behalf of Messrs. Hull & Chicken, Shipbrokers, both of this City, a marine boiler lying at Sunderland with a view to its being fitted in a vessel classed with this Society.

It appears that the boiler, 8' 6" x 8' 6", was made by Messrs. Samuel Hodge & Co., Union Iron Works, Milwall, for Messrs. Crabtree & Co., Yarmouth - Engine No.406 - and fitted in 1910 in the drifter "WEST ANGLIA"; further that the boiler was surveyed and tested by the Board of Trade Surveyors.

It is desired that the purchase should be completed with the least possible delay and we shall be glad to learn, by telegram, whether it is possible for you to obtain and approve a plan of the boiler and whether, after a satisfactory survey by the Society's Surveyors, the boiler would be accepted
