Dear Sir,

Reverting to my letter of the 7th instant respecting the steamer "LYNGHAUG", I have to inform you that in the absence of a reply to this communication the case has received the consideration of the General Committee at their meeting to-day, and that in the circumstances the Committee have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I may add that in view of the expunging of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
