I return herewith the drawing of stern gear and shafting proposed for your Engines No. 2678 for Messrs. Crichton's Yard No. 518, and have to say that with steam reciprocating engines, for River Service, having cylinders of $10\frac{1}{2}$ " and $17\frac{1}{2}$ " and $27\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter by 18" stroke, working pressure 200 lb. per square inch, diameter of propeller 6'1", screwshaft with continuous liner, the following sizes of shafting will be approved, viz:-
Thrust $5\frac{3}{8}$ ", Screw $5\frac{9}{16}$ " and intermediate $5\frac{1}{8}$ ".

I have to add that the plan of stern tube will also be approved.
