H. With reference to the classification of certain vessels belonging to Sovtorgflot etc., I beg to inform you that I am advised by Mr. Helyer that he has discussed with you cases in which surveys are long overdue and in which letters have been addressed to the Owners from this Office to which no replies have been received. Mr. Helyer further states that you are shortly proceeding to Moscow and that you propose taking up the matter with the Authorities with a view to ascertaining their intentions regarding the classification.

In the circumstances I enclose a list of such cases and in view of the fact that the surveys are very long overdue, I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know with the least possible delay what steps it is proposed to take to have the inspections held in order that the classes may be maintained.
