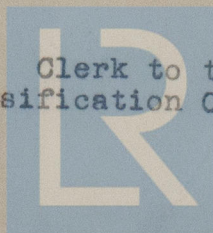
I take this opportunity to point out that the vessel will become due at the end of the present month for survey of the Screwshaft.
