With reference to your letter of the 19th inst. we beg to advise you that this vessel has been renamed "BAIKAL"; Port of Registry- Leningrad; new Owners- Sovtorgflot.

The name was originally painted on the vessel as "BIEKAL" and was so reported on your Report 8 No. 91074. It has, however, since been altered and we should be glad if our report might be amended accordingly.

We are informed by the Owners' Local Representatives that this vessel is proceeding light to Murmansk, expected to sail tomorrow night, and that the Authorities are, in the circumstances, allowing her to clear upon the old Freeboard Certificates in the name of "ROSEWORTH".
