Dear Sirs,

With reference to your first entry report No. 12575 on the Single Screw Steamer "ROSEWORTH", I have to inform you that the proportion of the fees which will be chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the survey of the vessel during construction up to the time of transfer to private ownership will be 40% of the difference between the fees as a Standard vessel and the ordinary classification fees in the case of the Hull, and 25% in the case of the Machinery, which will amount to £10 and £5 respectively.

An account is to-day being rendered to the Ministry of Shipping for the fees in question, and on payment your Office will be credited accordingly.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.

In connexion with this case I have to add that it is concluded that a semi-box beam is fitted on collision bulkhead as approved, but I shall be glad if you will state whether this is so.
