The 1st S.S.No.3 became due 7,33.

The vessel being laid up the Owners have furnished the usual undertaking.

The case received the consideration in September last, the Special Survey being then two years overdue, when ~~a~~ general examination was required.

The Buenos Aires Surveyors now report ^{satisfactory} a/general examination made of the vessel afloat, including the windlass and steering engine, which were found satisfactory.
