The Malmo Surveyor reports the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated.

The after part of No.3 hold extending from the engine room bulkhead (at frame 87) to frame 99 has been converted into a deep tank for the purpose of carrying vegetable oil in accordance with approved plan and amendments.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 6,37 and notation of 'Carrying cargo oil F.P. above 150° F in deep tank and tanks in way of tunnels'
