I duly received Mr. Beveridge's letter of the 23rd instant forwarding one from the Sunderland Forge & Engineering Co. Ltd., together with the report on electric lighting installation on the T.S.S. "ESSEQUIBO". It is noted that the electric light installation has been fitted in accordance with the Society's Rules with the exception that the main cable from the dynamo to the main switchboard is somewhat smaller in diameter than would be required by the present Rules if the total amperage of which the dynamo is capable were passed through it; further that there are many motors in this vessel and the generating plant is in excess of the full requirements of the vessel, and it is therefore unlikely that the full power can ever be used, and I have to acquaint you that in the circumstances the electric lighting installation will be approved in this instance.

The approved plans are returned herewith for reference in dealing with the sister vessel, in the case of
