

The Special Survey No.3 was carried out in July last at Southampton, and a notation of the survey was assigned, subject to some worn cable being renewed within three months, and to the hatch covers and wood decks being placed in order on her arrival at Leningrad, whither she was bound.

In reply to enquiries as to what steps have been taken to have the necessary repairs carried out at Leningrad, where the vessel has since arrived, the Owners now write that all the repairs will be carried out under the U.S.S.R's Register Control.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, the 20th ultimo, when, in the circumstances, they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
