The Modified Survey of the Oil Engines became due on this vessel in August, 1935, and has been partly held.

In reply to enquiry the Society's Genoa Surveyors now forward a translation of a letter from the Owners to the effect that on account of administrative complications and costs of dual classification they have decided to withdraw the class of this vessel.

The Genoa Surveyors, in forwarding this letter, state that in conversation with Captain Corrado, representing the Owners, he expressed his thanks for the Society's services in the past and his regret at having to withdraw the vessel from class.

The case was submitted to the Classing Committee on Tuesday, the 8th instant, when, in the circumstances, instructions were given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
