The Special Survey No.3 became due in May, 1933,
and the vessel being laid up, the Owners have furnished the
usual undertaking.

A letter has now been received from the London
Agents stating they have been informed by the Owners
it is their intention to obtain a certificate of seaworthiness
from the Mexican Government (the vessel being under the
Mexican flag), and that on receipt of this certificate they
will load her with a cargo for this Country, after discharge
of which she will be sold for breaking up purposes. They add
that this action will, of course, automatically cancel the
vessel's classification with this Society.

The year of grace expired in May, 1934.

The Classing Committee had the case before them
on Tuesday, 29th instant, when they decided to give
instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the
Register Book with a Red Line (10,35), indicating non-
compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners' Agents
have been informed accordingly.
