
Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 6th instant having reference to the printed form of undertaking which was forwarded for your signature in connexion with the overdue Special Survey No.3 of your steamer "SAN UGON", which is at present laid up in Tampico.

The Committee note what you say with regard to the steps you are taking whilst the vessel is laid up to keep her in good condition, and they quite realise that as the facilities available at Tampico are not suitable for carrying out the survey and repairs which may be necessary, the wording of the undertaking, which implies that if the vessel were to leave her class would be automatically cancelled, may involve some hardship.

As you state that it is your fixed intention to send the vessel direct from Tampico to Mobile in ballast for the carrying out of the survey and docking, should you decide to recommission her any time, I have the pleasure to say that the Committee will raise no objection to this procedure and would agree to ~~your~~ modifying the form of undertaking to read as you suggest.

I would add, however that if the lying-up period

is unduly prolonged the Committee might consider it necessary for one of the Society's Surveyors to make a general examination of the vessel before she left to ascertain that she is in a fit condition for the contemplated voyage.
