Nature of Survey

When due

The class is subject to permanent repairs being effected to damaged shell plating etc. on starboard side at Owners' convenience.

The 1st S.S.No.3 became due 9,36 and a proposal to take advantage of the year of grace was agreed to.

A subsequent proposal by the Owners to carry part of the Special Survey this month and postpone the remaining items for a year was not agreed to. X

It was suggested that very little extra time would be required to complete the Survey at this time.

The attached letter has now been received from the Bergen Surveyor enclosing one from the Owners to the effect that it is desired that the vessel's class should be dealt with, it is intended to transfer the vessel to the Norske Veritas, who stated have concurred in the Owners' wishes regarding completion of the Survey in the Spring of 1938.

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
