With reference to your letter of the 5th inst., forwarding freeboard certificates in the case of the above mentioned vessel, I wish to state that having communicated with the San Francisco Surveyors, they now state that the depth of the hatch webs was 15" below the wood hatch covers at the center and 7½" deep at the side. Alternate webs extended to the top of the covers and were 18" in depth at center and 10½" at the side.
