

with record 11.16,

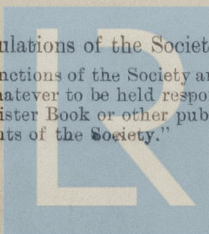
