Dear Mr Carey,

I am in receipt of your letter of 24th inst. regarding Messrs Robey & Co., of Lincoln, Engines Nos. 27018 and 27019. These Engines were afterwards known as Messrs Kincaid & Co., of Greenock (Formerly Caird & Co.), Nos. 564 and 565, and were erected by Messrs Kincaid, and sent to Vancouver to be fitted on board Vessels building by Messrs Coughlan & Sons.

Kincaid's No. 564 are to be fitted to the S.S. "CANADIAN INVENTOR", for which the arranged Special Fee of £50 was charged - Greenock Report No. 17571, dated 28th November, 1919.

Kincaid's No. 565, as per Greenock Report No. 17584, dated 19th December, 1919, was also sent to Vancouver. In this case, the First Entry Fee of £3 and the ordinary Fee of £22-19/- has been rendered to Messrs Kincaid.
