S. With reference to your letter of the 12th ultimo respecting the steamer "KARAVADOS", ex "Dah Loh", I have to acquaint that, the year of grace for the 2nd Special Survey No.3 of this vessel having expired at the end of last month, the case was today submitted for the consideration of the Committee, who, in the absence of any arrangements having apparently been made for this inspection to be carried out, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
