Nature of Survey Final Entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the Boston Surveyor should be requested to state clearly the size of the frames fitted in the Engine and Boiler space, and also whether the bulkhead on Frame No. 97 has been constructed as shewn on the approved plan as unless this has been done, it cannot be included in the number of water tight bulkheads recorded in the Register Book. He should also state whether section 49 of the Rules has been complied with and whether the oil fuel tank has been tested as required by the Rules.
