Dear Soden,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 20th. instant in regard to the dimensions of the "VICTOLITE" and Mr. Munro has made enquiries of the Board of Trade here.

It appears that the registered depth of 38.00 feet is correct. The figure 38.41 feet for the depth from top of keel to top of beam amidships should be 39.41 feet and the Board of Trade are taking this matter up with the Builders, who supplied the figures. The registered depth of 38 feet should, therefore, be adhered to.
