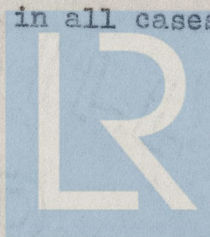

M. Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 1st instant enclosing a plan (in duplicate) of shifting beams for the cargo hatchways in upper and tween decks for Messrs. Howaldtswerke's Yard No. 765, and to inform you that the scantlings of the beams as shown and amended on the plan of shifting beams on the upper and second decks will be approved.

The details of the arrangements at the ends of these beams is, however, not quite understood from the sketch, and I shall be glad if you will forward the detail plan of the web carrier marked 2/53 on the plan, together with an explanation of the method proposed to be adopted for shipping and securing the beams.

At the same time you should draw the Builders' attention to Section 25, paragraph 4(c) of the Rules, which requires the angles on the upper edge of the beams to extend to the extreme end of the beam in all cases.
