As requested in your letter of the 24th instant, I enclose herewith plans of the panting arrangements and of the fore peak bulkhead as adopted in the case of the S.S. "THISTLEMORE", recently completed by Messrs. Irvine's S.B. & D.D. Co. Ltd.,

These plans are similar to the arrangements as approved for the S.S. "START POINT" built last year by Messrs. Laing & Sons of Sunderland.

On account of the difficulty in obtaining wood at the present time, the Owners did not specify that cargo battens should be fitted in the shelter 'tween decks and these were not fitted in this case.
