I enclose herewith copy of a letter addressed by me on April 1st, 1915, to the New York Shipbuilding Company, regarding a rough draft midship section and general arrangement of their S. S. No. 169, proposed to be built by them for the Coastwise Transportation Company of Boston, as a duplicate of the S. S. "COASTWISE" built by them for the same Owners. Nothing further was heard from the Builders in regard to this matter, and the vessel has been built to class with the American Bureau of Shipping.

The Owners have now made application with a view to having this vessel classed with this Society, and with regard thereto I have forwarded a midship section and general arrangement plan, together with seventeen detail plans, which are submitted for the favourable consideration of the Committee.
