I am in receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo submitting for consideration plan of midship section and general arrangement of the S.S.No.169 proposed to be built by you, and with regard thereto I have the pleasure to acquaint you that, provided the arrangements as shown and amended be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A1.

The steel used in the construction of the vessel should be made at Works recognized by the Committee and be tested by the Society's Surveyors in accordance with the Rules.
