Nature of Survey _____

First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Genoa Surveyors should be requested to return the approved plans of the rigging, of the oil fuel tank forward, the bulkhead plans, ~~the approved profile, and the plan of the wide spread plating.~~

At the same time they should be requested to state whether the oil fuel tank has been tested as required by the Rules, and also whether the whole of the requirements of Section 49 of the rules have been complied with, ~~and~~ whether the space under the engines is used for oil fuel, and if so whether it has been tested.

They should also state whether cargo battens have been fitted as shewn on the approved midship section and whether the height of the floors at the bilges is 650 m/m as reported or 800 m/m as ~~required by the Rules.~~ shown on the approved midship section.
