Gentlemen,

S. With reference to your first entry report No.3619 on the machinery of the steamer "CEREA", I have to point out that before the certificates can be issued in the case of this vessel it is necessary for the safety valves to be adjusted under steam, and as this does not appear to have been done although the statements in your first entry machinery report are not quite in agreement on the point, I have to request that you will be good enough to telegraph to this Office as soon as all the safety valves have been satisfactorily adjusted with a view to the case being submitted to the Committee for classification of the vessel.
