Remarks of Surveyor

First entry

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the London Surveyors should be informed that the machinery of this vessel is to be fitted in her at Yarmouth, and they should be requested to see that the decks, water-ways and deck pumps are satisfactorily completed and tested in accordance with the Rules, the rudder stops on deck fitted and the riveting of the casing completed to their satisfaction. On completion of the same they should report particulars on form No.8 for the information of the Committee, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
