The propelling machinery of this vessel consists of steam reciprocating engines combined with a Bauer-Wach L.P. turbine.

The reciprocating engines and boilers were made by Messrs. Rankin and Blackmore Ltd., Greenock and the L.P. turbine by Messrs. Wm. Beardmore & Co., Dalmuir.

The N.H.P. of the combined machinery is 473 and the special survey fee would be £95.19.0.

As the steam turbine was constructed at Works other than those at which the main propelling machinery was constructed, the Glasgow Office charged a fee of £10 in accordance with the usual practice and credited the Greenock Surveyors with 1/3 of that amount (i.e. £3.6.8) for the installing of the turbine on board.

The Greenock Surveyors now state that in the circumstances they charged the fees of £88.0.0. on the basis of 420 N.H.P. which is that for the reciprocating machinery.

This means that as regards the special survey fees the total amount will be:-
