The Genoa Surveyor has been informed by the Owner, that the vessel is expected at Torre Annunziata in about 8 days, but he is not quite sure whether the survey will be completed there; if it is not, the vessel goes to Rotterdam at the end of the month for new boilers, when all overdue surveys will be completed.
