
Sir

I beg to forward you per Commercial Paper Post, the approved plans of the new Italian Steamer "Tuno", built by Mess<sup>rs</sup> Orlando, asked with yours of the 14<sup>th</sup> inst, to be compared with my Report sent to you. Please, return them to me as soon as possible.

I take the liberty to say now, that Mess<sup>rs</sup> Orlando find some difficulty to hand these plans, knowing that you already hold an approved copy, as stated also in yours of 25<sup>th</sup> July 1898.

With reference to your remarks I beg to inform you that in lieu of the steam chain given in my Report of the S/S "Tuno", will be supplied by a wire hawser and in lieu of hemp continue one steel wire will be supplied on the arrival of the Vessel at Cardiff where she is bound to day.
