
Dear Sir,

H. With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steel screw ketches "LINARES" and "LINDORES", I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know what arrangements you propose making for the Special Annual Survey of the engines of these vessels, which became due at the end of last month, to be carried out.

The following requires to be done in order to comply with the Society's Rules, viz:—The cylinders, pistons, connecting rods, crank and other shafts, inlet and exhaust valves and gear, clutches, reversing gear, propeller, sea connections and pumps to be examined. The fuel tanks and all connections are to be examined, and if deemed necessary by the Surveyor to be tested to the same pressure as required when new. If practicable, the engines should be tested under working conditions.
