These vessels, which were built during the war for the Government and belonged to the "Kil" class, originally held the character "A1 - For Government Service".

Alterations were subsequently effected with a view to the class "100A1" being assigned.

They have recently been sold to Germany, and the new Owners state that the vessels have been transferred to the classification of the Germanischer Lloyd.

In the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the cases before them on Friday, 16th instant, decided to give instructions for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
