Messrs. Sandilands Buttery & Co. Lloyd's Agents, Penang, and with the consent of the Owners' agents, board the S.S. "MATA HARI" (No. in Reg. Book 30781) for the purpose of ascertaining the extent of the damage done when the Vessel grounded in Penang harbour on the morning of the 8th March, 1934.

The Vessel was proceeding to her anchorage when she grounded. The Vessel floated at high water.

As far as could be ascertained, the Vessel was not damaged and was not making water. The Vessel was allowed to proceed on her voyage.

A Seaworthy Certificate was handed to the Owners' Agents.
